PINOT GRIGIO 2013

Name Alto Adige Pinot Grigio DOC

This elegant white wine has its origins in Burgundy. It has a pleasant aroma, a fresh, smooth taste and is unobtrusively flowery.

Production Area grows on fine sand and silt soils around the village St. Pauls(300–500m a.s.l.).

Aging slow fermentation at controlled temperature in stainless steel followed by maturation on fine yeast for 5 – 7 months.



PINOT BIANCO RISERVA PASSION 2011

Name Alto Adige Pinot Bianco DOC

A wine that impresses with its complexity and sophisticated aroma of peaches and apples and is very textured on the palate with mineral tones.

Production Area Eppan Berg, at approx. 600m above sea level, position to south-west.

Aging fermented and matured in a large oak barrel for eight months, then bottled about one years later, 20,000 bottles.
